


SCHOLA simulation



Prendo's Schola simulation provides an intense but risk-free experience of planning and controlling a project

The “whole project in 1 day” simulation is used in online, classroom, project start-up and assessment events

Who is it for?

Schola is regularly used by:

- project & program managers
- project controls specialists
- project team members

as well as Masters and E/MBAs, and executives on business school programs

Key Outcomes

Participants develop skills in a number of techniques, including:

- scheduling: critical path analysis, gantt charts
- project planning & control techniques
- budgeting & cashflow management
- earned value management
- risk management
- judging time-cost-quality trade-offs

The topics it covers include:

- project planning & control
- project management essentials
- earned value management
- managing risk & uncertainty

Logistics

- the simulation workshop can be run with anything from 6–100 participants, in a 1-2 day timeframe
- it can be run with teams in classroom workshops; or in online events with remote participants
- each team needs an internet-connected computer (PC or Mac)

Why Simulate?

- Developing skills by listening and reading doesn't work
- Today's learners expect more effective methods
- People only develop skills by practising them
- Simulations provide accelerated and risk-free experiences
- It's irresponsible not to when the stakes are high
- Learners can see the crucial links between cause and effect
- Making mistakes in the real world is less likely
